Entrepreneurs create wheelchair lift system

Device allows motorists to drive without leaving chair

JERSEYVILLE — Coming soon to area garages: the ability to transform regulation automobiles into handicapped-accessible ones — without changing the vehicle's outward appearance.

The means is a new product, a patent-pending wheelchair lift system, that is the result of teamwork between Scott Darnell and

David Gotter, who have co-founded a company called Further OPTIONS. The lift is the company's first commercial product and will be available after Feb. 1.

The company is taking potential orders for its DMS-3 Pickup truck Wheelchair Entry System, which uses the standard lift for a wheelchair and allows a driver to access the vehicle compartment to
